#### **ONE-TO-ONE BUSINESS ADVICE CASE STUDY**

#### The So & So Arts Club

With the support of London Business Hub, The So & So Arts Club is empowered to push through the challenges of COVID-19.

Founder and Artistic Director, Sarah Berger, started the So & So Arts Club nine years ago after 32 years as an actress. The business was established with a vision to form a broad community of people from across the creative industry, to open doors and build a supportive network and platform to develop paid professional opportunities.

As with so many other many other small businesses, the COVID-19 pandemic introduced immediate and disastrous circumstances for Sarah's business. She had to close during lockdown and it was unclear when she would be able to reopen. Financial implications led to future commitments and programmes being postponed and difficult decisions regarding staff along the way.

Initially the So & So Arts Club reached out to the London Business Hub to look for financial aid and advice to help pivot and restructure the business in order to survive.

The allocated business adviser provided general business advice specific to the industry. Moreover, he provided avenues for seeking financial help and connected Sarah with helpful contacts, such as the local authority who could support the business. Sarah found great comfort in having a listening ear and practical, professional guidance to help with the club's particular set of challenges in a complex and ever-changing situation.

I would wholeheartedly recommend the London Business Hub as it has been an invaluable source of advice and support for both the business and me personally. At a time when the pressure seemed insurmountable and I came close to giving up, it gave me the strength and purpose to carry on.

## Quantemol

Quantemol was founded in 2004 by two University College London academics, Professor Jonathan Tennyson and Dr Daniel Brown. The company provides quantum-level solutions for plasma modelling which is used extensively in the manufacturing of microchips and in multiple other industrial applications, from air purification to medicine.

As the COVID-19 pandemic hit, Quantemol faced a state of uncertainty about the future impact.

The business needed to quickly make a decision about their London office during the lockdown and devise a strategy to keep afloat and retain their highly qualified staff – "I wanted to do something, but lacked a clear vision of what would be most helpful" says Anna Dzarasova, CEO at Quantemol.

#### **GET INVESTMENT READY CASE STUDY**

#### **iParcelBox**

iParcelBox is a London-based electronics manufacturer that creates innovative parcel storage products. The company's flagship product, the iParcelBox, provides a smart, secure and weatherproof place for parcels to be delivered that can be monitored from a smartphone.

The idea for iParcelBox came to founder Paul Needler after yet another 'Sorry we missed you' card laid on his doormat. Facing the prospect of a Saturday morning queuing outside the post office, Paul decided to look for solutions.

He set to work creating a prototype of the iParcelBox. In 2018, Paul decided to patent the technology and turn the product into a business.

The COVID-19 pandemic disrupted Paul's plans for expansion in 2020 and posed unique challenges to his business. His product is designed to receive deliveries when people are not there to do it themselves, so with the population confined to their homes throughout 2020, demand for the iParcel Box reduced.

However while consumer sales dropped, the company simultaneously saw a boom in business customers who needed to exchange goods or paperwork with their customers while remaining contact-free.

With this new-found small-business customer base, Paul wanted to get his growth plans back on track and begin attracting external investment.

He had previously heard of the London Business Hub's Investment Readiness Programme, so approached them to help get his company ready for external investment and growth. A group of finance specialists worked with Paul to understand his business before guiding him through important aspects of the investment process. These included accessing equity and loan financing, getting the best out of Accelerator programmes, approaching venture capitalists and business angels, avoiding common pitfalls and, of course, referrals to investors.

We found it really helpful to be able to rehearse our pitch in front of 'real' investors and get their feedback. The programme also gave us valuable insights into the different options available for funding, and what they would be looking for from us.

#### PROPERTY ADVICE SERVICE CASE STUDY

### Spa de Sal

Spa de Sal is a London-based spa that specialises in salt therapy for the treatment of respiratory and skin conditions. The business had a strong start to 2020; however progress was halted when the spa was forced to close through three national lockdowns and the stopping of all treatments. As with many businesses during this time, cashflow started to become an issue, and founder Matilda Goes became concerned about her more significant costs, like rent.

Matilda learned about the resources at the London Business Hub from the Hounslow Council, which outlined services on offer such as grant support, training, and webinars. She took part in the London Business Property Advice service and registered for a free, one-to-one session with a highly experienced property lawyer to discuss her concerns around her rent.

During their session, business adviser Richard worked with Matilda to fully understand her situation and her business. He helped her draft a message to her landlord and Matilda was able to agree adjustments to her payments, meaning she could cover her monthly outgoings with her existing cashflow and support from government grants.

The webinars and one-to-one meetings with the advisers helped Matilda to think strategically and objectively about how to support her business during a time of uncertainty. It helped her to map out her priorities and provided her with the knowledge and guidance needed to protect her business.



Richard was my knight in shining armour! He understood my situation and sent me a draft text to adapt and send to my landlord to ask for concessions including aadjustments to my payment plan. By staggering rent payments for a time, I was able to focus my cashflow on other areas of the business. It was great to have someone guiding and supporting me through a very difficult, uncertain time.
